
Expert Reports become part of the official trial packet once they have been submitted to the Clerk of the Court. Expert witnesses <u>may not testify to or offer an opinion that is not contained in their submitted report</u>. An expert may not add information to or in any way alter the contents of their Expert Report after it has been submitted. If an expert witness adds information to the Expert Report or changes any information, the opposing party may use the submitted Expert Report to impeach the witness.

On **Monday, March 16th, 2015**, a representative of each team may retrieve their opposing team's Expert Report from the Clerk of the Court.

If a team fails to submit an expert report, their expert witness **may not** offer their own opinion as to the meaning of the online video submitted by Jesse, Exhibit L.

In preparation for the second round of the Mock Trial Tournament, on **Friday, March** 21st, 2014, a representative of each team may retrieve the Expert Report of the team they will be opposing in the second round from the office of the Clerk of the Court.
